Who is Jesus?	In this module, the students encounter some of the stories of Jesus, which illustrate the qualities of Jesus as demonstrated by His interactions with people of His day.		
Jesus Shows God's Love	John 5:1-14; Luke 19:1-6 (healing a sick man, Zacchaeus)	Jesus demonstrated God's love to people.	Care and Compassion Integrity Respect

Communicating	This module introduces the students to the Lord's Prayer, which was taught to the disciples by Jesus.		
The God Who Speaks	Luke 11:1-4 ; Matthew 13:3-9; (the Lord's Prayer, Parable of the Sower)	Jesus taught His disciples a prayer called the Lord's Prayer, which communicates the greatness and goodness of God.	Integrity Doing Your Best Respect

Easter	Exploration around the identity of Jesus, as seen through the events of the first Easter, will be the focus of this module.		
What's Special about Jesus?	Luke 9:28-36 (transfiguration)	Christians believe that the Bible teaches that Jesus is special; that He is God's Son.	Respect Integrity Care and Compassion
Like a Mother Hen	Matthew 11:28-30; 23:37-39; Exodus 19:4; Deuteronomy 32:11-12; Ruth 2: 12 and Psalm 17:8-9	Jesus described His care for people like that of a mother hen to her chickens.	Respect Integrity Care and Compassion
Jesus, the Prince of Peace	Matthew 21:1-11; John 12:12-15, Zechariah 9:9, 10 (entry into Jerusalem)	Jesus was recognised as the Prince of Peace by those on the first Palm Sunday.	Respect Fair Go Freedom
Easter Surprise	Luke 24:1-49; John 20: 9-21 (Jesus is alive)	Christians believe that Jesus is alive, having risen from the dead on the first Easter Sunday.	Respect Care and Compassion Freedom

Friends	This module explores some of the qualities of friends that were demonstrated in Jesus: care, helpfulness, respect, forgiveness and loyalty; qualities that enrich both individuals and communities.		
Friends Care	John 2:1-11 (the wedding at Cana)	Friends care about one another. The Bible shows that Jesus was a caring friend to others.	Care and Compassion Doing Your Best Friendship
Friends Help	Matthew 4:18-22 (Jesus chooses helpers)	Friends are willing to help one another. The Bible records that Jesus chose friends to help Him.	Doing Your Best Friendship Responsibility & Respect Teamwork
Friends Listen	Matthew 21:28-32 (parable of the two sons)	Friends listen to each other and respond to what they hear.	Honesty and Trustworthiness Integrity Responsibility and Respect
Friends Forgive	Luke 15:11-32 (the prodigal son)	Friends forgive. Christians believe that God forgives us as His friends and wants us to forgive our friends.	Honesty and Trustworthiness Integrity Freedom and Forgiveness Understanding, Tolerance and Inclusion
Friend of Everyone	Mark 10:46-52 (Bartimaeus)	Jesus is a friend of everyone, even those that others exclude.	Care and Compassion Integrity Responsibility and Respect Understanding, Tolerance and Inclusion
Heroes of the Faith	The students will learn of people who have lived out the Christian faith in their lives, contributing to the common good.

Love Your Enemies	Matthew 5:43-48 (love your enemies)	Loving our enemies and responding well to hurtful behaviour makes a positive difference.	Care and Compassion Fair Go Understanding, Tolerance and Inclusion Love and Forgiveness
Be Generous	Matthew 6:1-4 (generosity without an audience)	The Bible tells us to give from a generous heart, rather than to make ourselves look good in front of others.	Care and Compassion Doing Your Best Generosity Kindness
Treasure Chests	Matthew 6:19-21 (treasures in earth/ in heaven)	The Bible tells us to treasure what lasts forever.	Care and Compassion Responsibility and Respect Love

Ask, Seek, Knock	Matthew 7:7-11; Luke 11:5-8 (ask, seek, knock)	The Bible tells us that we can talk to God about what we need because He wants good things for us.	Doing Your Best Freedom Persistence
Good Fruit	Matthew 7:16-18 (trees and fruit)	You can tell what a person is really like on the inside by what they do on the outside.	Doing Your Best Integrity Friendship
Christmas	In this module, the students will explore the identity of the person at the centre of the Christmas story, Jesus from the perspective of those to whom His birth was announced.		
Born Like Me	Matthew 1:18-2, Luke 1:26-56; 2:1-7 (angels visit Elizabeth, Mary and Joseph)	According to the Bible, Jesus is special as suggested by the events surrounding His birth.	Respect Integrity Doing Your Best
Shepherds Visit	Luke 2:8-20 (shepherds visit)	According to the Bible, Jesus is special; shepherds were told of His birth and visited Him.	Respect Integrity Freedom
Gifts from Faraway	Matthew 2:1-12 (Wise Men visit)	According to the Bible, Jesus is special; people from far away were told of His birth and came to worship Him.	Respect Integrity Honesty and Trustworthiness
